## Course Sequence Guide

### B.B.A. Degree in Sport, Event and Tourism Management

This course sequence guide is designed to assist students in completing their UTSA undergraduate business degree requirements. *This is a term-by-term sample course guide. Students must satisfy other requirements in their catalog and meet with an academic advisor in the College of Business Undergraduate Advising Center for an individualized degree plan. The milestones to the right of each term are designed to keep students on track to graduate in four years. Milestones are courses and special requirements necessary for timely progress to complete a major. If a milestone is not achieved, it may result in delayed graduation or a required major change.* Progress within this guide depends upon such factors as course availability, individual student academic preparation, student time management, work obligations, and individual financial considerations.

Students may choose to take courses during Summer terms to reduce course loads during long semesters.
