Award: One award; amount varies

- Pursuing a degree in the College of Business at the undergraduate level
- Minimum 2.75 cumulative grade point average
- Preference given to students demonstrating the greatest financial need
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

The Alamo Asian American Chamber of Commerce Annual Scholarship

Award: \$1,000 a year; number of awards vary

- Declared major in the College of Business at the undergraduate or graduate level
- Undergraduates must have completed a minimum of 60 semester credit hours
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT:** Must submit a paper of no less than 600 words resulting from an interview with a business member of the Alamo Asian American Chamber of Commerce (see www.alamo-aacc.org - then click on "Members")

- Minimum 2.50 cumulative grade point average

Award: One award of \$5,000 a year

- Graduate student admitted to any graduate business major in the College of Business
- Preference will be given to students who are admitted on a probationary status
- Preference will be given to students who are bilingual in English and Spanish
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the Office of Student Financial Aid
- Must be enrolled for at least 9 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

The Bartlett Cocke Executive-In-Residence Endowed Scholarship

Award: Number and amount of awards vary

- Declared major in the College of Business at the undergraduate or graduate level
- Undergraduates must have completed a minimum of 30 semester credit hours

Award: One award; amount varies

- Declared major in the College of Business at the undergraduate level
- Must demonstrate leadership and community/university involvement in résumé/attached narrative
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the Office of Student Financial Aid
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

The CREW-San Antonio Scholarship in Real Estate Finance and Development

Award: One award of \$1,500 a year

- Declared major in the real estate finance and development in the College of Business
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as an undergraduate or at least 9 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as a graduate

Award: Number and amount of awards vary

- Declared major in the College of Business at the undergraduate or graduate level
- Preference given to graduate students
- Undergraduates must have completed a minimum of 30 semester credit hours
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as an undergraduate or at least 9 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as a graduate

Award: Number and amount of awards vary

- Declared information systems major in the College of Business
- Undergraduates must have completed a minimum of 60 semester credit hours

- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

Department of Management Science & Statistics Scholarship

Award: One award of \$1,500 a year

- Declared major in actuarial science in the College of Business
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- In the event that there is no undergraduate candidate that meet all the requirements in any given year, this scholarship may be awarded to a full-time graduate student who is in good academic standing and meets the above requirements or an equivalent major.
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

- Declared undergraduate finance, accounting, management or marketing major in the College of Business
- Undergraduates must have completed a minimum of 30 semester credit hours

- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the Office of Student Financial Aid
- Must be U.S. citizen or permanent resident alien
- Preference will be given to students from traditionally underrepresented populations in approved majors
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

The Warner F. Fassnidge Annual Scholarship in Real Estate Finance and Development

Award: One award of \$2,500 a year

- Declared undergraduate construction management or real estate finance and development major in the College of Business
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must be enrolled for at least 6 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

The Fiesta Texas Scholarship

Award: \$500 a year; number of awards vary

- Pursuing a degree in tourism management or in marketing with a tourism concentration
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the Office of Student Financial Aid
- Among equally qualified applicants, preference will be given to Hispanic or African-American students.
- Preference will be given to students demonstrating participation and leadership in community, university, and/or extracurricular activities
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

The Frost Bank Endowed Scholarship

Award: One award; amount varies

- Pursuing a degree in the College of Business at the undergraduate level
- Must have completed a minimum of 45 semester credit hours
- Minimum 2.75 cumulative grade point average
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the Office of Student Financial Aid
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

T.C. Frost Endowed Scholarship for Citizenship

Award: One award; amount varies

- Pursuing a degree in the College of Business at the undergraduate level

Award: Number and amount of awards vary

- Declared undergraduate construction management or real estate finance and development major in the College of Business
- Must have completed a minimum of 60 semester credit hours
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

The H-E-B Endowed Scholarship

Award: One award and amount varies

- Declared major in the College of Business at the undergraduate or graduate level
- Undergraduates must have completed at least 60 semester credit hours
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must have related work experience in retailing or supervising or campus leadership through present or past officer (chair) status in a professional club or organization
- Narrative on career goals and intentions must express sincere interest in retailing/food area
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as an undergraduate or at least 9 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as a graduate

The Jerry & Mary Keating Endowed Scholarship in Statistics

Award: One award; amount varies

- Declared statistics major in the College of Business
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must have attained at least junior class standing as an undergraduate
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as an undergraduate or at least 6 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as a graduate

The Rosemary Kowlaski Endowed Scholarship

Award: One award; amount varies

- Declared major in the College of Business at the undergraduate or graduate level
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must have completed a minimum of 30 semester credit hours as an undergraduate
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as an undergraduate or at least 9 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as a graduate

The Quincy Lee Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Award: Number and amount of awards vary

- Declared major in the College of Business at the undergraduate level
- Must have completed a minimum of 80 semester credit hours
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT:** Must submit a written essay on business ethics, approximately two pages double-spaced, to be judged by a joint committee of College of Business and San Antonio Real Estate Council representatives.
- Preference given to applicants who have completed business ethics and principles of real estate and who have enrolled in mortgage banking and real estate finance.
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

The William Mastoris, Jr. Endowed Business Scholarship

Award: One award; amount varies

- Pursuing a degree in the College of Business at the undergraduate or graduate level
- Undergraduates must have completed a minimum of 30 semester credit hours
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as an undergraduate or at least 9 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as a graduate

The Bob & Loys Mickey Memorial Scholarship

Award: One award of \$2,500 a year

- Declared major in the College of Business at the undergraduate or graduate level
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the Office of Student Financial Aid
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as an undergraduate or at least 9 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as a graduate

NACUBO Endowed Scholarship

Award: One award; amount varies

- Declared undergraduate human resource management major in the College of Business
- Must have completed a minimum of 60 semester credit hours
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

The North Loop 410 Association, Inc. Endowed Scholarship

Award: One award in fall semester only and amount varies

- Pursuing a degree in the College of Business at the undergraduate level
- Must be a Texas resident
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall

North San Antonio Chamber of Commerce Lead SA Charitable Foundation Scholarship

Award: \$2,500 in spring semester only; number of awards vary and are dependent on available funding

- Undergraduate student attending final semester in spring who has applied for graduation by the appropriate deadline
- Must have completed high school education in Bexar County, Texas
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT:** A separate scholarship application must be submitted along with a 500 word essay on “Why I am Interested in a Career in Business”
- Demonstrate recognizable merit, leadership skills and interest in community activities
- Financial need is a consideration
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

The Shelly Palmer Memorial Scholarship Fund

Award: \$500 a year; number of awards vary

- Declared undergraduate marketing major
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Financial need, number of hours completed, and involvement in extracurricular and civic activities is a consideration
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

The Marie L. Pauerstein Endowed Tourism Management Scholarship

Award: One award; amount varies

- Declared major in tourism management or in marketing with a tourism concentration
- Minimum 2.50 cumulative grade point average
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

Award: One award of \$2,500 a year

- Declared major in the College of Business at the undergraduate level
- Must have completed a minimum of 60 semester credit hours
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

Lieutenant Colonel Philip J. Piccione Endowed Scholarship

Award: One award; amount varies

- Pursuing a degree in the College of Business at the undergraduate level
- Must have completed a minimum 60 semester credit hours
- Minimum 2.50 cumulative grade point average
- Must be a Texas resident and U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the Office of Student Financial Aid
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

Rackspace Scholarship Fund

Award: Two awards at \$500 and two awards at \$1,000

- Declared major in information systems at the undergraduate or graduate level
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Must demonstrate significant financial need as determined by the Office of Student Financial Aid
- Preference will be given to students from demonstrably underrepresented student populations and students whose parents did not complete college.
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as an undergraduate or at least 9 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as a graduate

Award: One award; amount varies

- Declared major in the College of Business at the undergraduate level
- Must have completed a minimum of 80 semester credit hours
- Minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average
- Preference will be given to first generation college students
- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

San Antonio Hotel & Lodging Association Endowed Tourism Management Scholarship

Award: Number and amount of awards vary

- Declared major in tourism management or in marketing with a tourism concentration
- Minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average
- Preference will be given to applicants who are currently working or have worked in the accommodations industry
- Must be enrolled for at least 9 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring

- Must be enrolled for at least 12 or more semester credit hours in the fall and spring as an undergraduate
