PROGRAM OVERVIEW

UT Health San Antonio Long School of Medicine is accepting applications for the University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA) Executive MBA (EMBA) for Health Professionals program. Taught by award-winning UTSA Carlos Alvarez College of Business faculty, this program is for **UT Health San Antonio Long School of Medicine** senior health professionals interested in further developing their business and leadership skills. The UTSA EMBA for Health Professionals extends the standard EMBA curriculum into the healthcare industry, with the goal of complementing specialized healthcare expertise with general business knowledge and leadership skills. In consultation with the Vice Dean for Clinical Affairs, a project focused on a mutually agreed upon aspect of UT Health will be required.

APPLICATION

The deadline for complete submissions is **midnight on Monday, March 18, 2024**. You must satisfy UTSA's university-wide graduate requirements and complete the online application (https://utsa2023.liaisoncas.com).

- Start by creating an application profile. Select program level "Masters" and applicant type "Graduate Degree Seeking."
- After completing your profile, select the "Add Program" tab and choose "Executive MBA, Master of Business Administration - FALL 2024." Then complete the personal information, academic history and supporting information. You will be asked to provide the following:
 - A current CV.
 - A 1,000 word (or less) personal statement describing personal and professional goals, reasons for pursuing the EMBA, and how the EMBA might facilitate or advance UT Health San Antonio strategic initiatives as they relate to your leadership position(s).
 - Names and email addresses for two letters of recommendation, including one from a supervisor. Letter of recommendation from supervisor must also include departmental or divisional support indicating guaranteed release time during scheduled sessions.
 - Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended.
 - Application fee code—request from Stephanie Gutierrez (Gutierrezsr@uthscsa.edu)
 and upload it to your application to waive the application fee.

You must click the "submit" button to complete your application. The EMBA Admissions Committee will review all applications and select candidates for an interview prior to acceptance into the program. Decisions announced **April 2024.**
